A string

The A string staff shows five finger patterns. Pattern 1 (Major) uses fingers 1, (II) 1, 2, 4. Pattern 2 (Minor) uses fingers 1, 2, (II) 2, 4. Pattern 3 (like Major) uses fingers 1, (II) 1, 3, 4. Pattern 4 (low 1) uses a flat finger 1, X2, (III) 1, 3. Pattern 5 (half position) uses a flat finger 1, X2, (III) 1, 2.

D string

The D string staff shows five finger patterns. Pattern 1 (Major) uses fingers 1, (II) 1, 2, 4. Pattern 2 (Minor) uses fingers 1, 2, (II) 2, 4. Pattern 3 (like Major) uses fingers 1, (II) 1, 3, 4. Pattern 4 (low 1) uses a flat finger 1, X2, (III) 1, 3. Pattern 5 (half position) uses a flat finger 1, X2, (III) 1, 2.

G string
